

KMUTT'S 'SPIN, PEDAL, SHARE BLESSINGS YEAR 2' - A SUSTAINABLE INITIATIVE ON NATIONAL CHILDREN'S DAY



On January 14, 2023, in celebration of National Children's Day, King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi (KMUTT), led by its Sustainable Activity Promotion Group and the Energy, Environmental, Safety, and Occupational Health Management Center (EESH Center), in collaboration with the KMUTT Green Bicycle Club, organized the "Spin, Pedal, Share Blessings Year 2" event at the Darul Ibadah community. The event was part of the KMUTT Walk & Bike Society, promoting sustainable cycling and walking society.
