Executives, faculty, students, the safety and emergency response team of KMUTT, Bang Pakok Hospital 1, Rat Burana Fire and Rescue Station, and Rat Burana Police Station participated and observed the drill, providing guidance and suggestions. With over 200 participants, this activity aligns with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), specifically Goal 11: Sustainable Cities and Communities, emphasizing the importance of safety for students and university staff.
